

First Conditional

We use the **first conditional**:

- A possible situation in the future.
- Predicting a likely result in the future (if the condition happens)

Also we can put either part of the sentence first.
When using If + negative we can use **unless**.

If + present simple, future simple
//
Future simple if + present simple

Examples:

- 1) If you **study** hard, you **will pass** the exam.
- 2) You **won't win**, if you **don't train**
- 3) You won't win **unless** you train.
