CD player Game "Speaker's Box" by Learning Resources	STUDENTS LEVEL: BEGINNER - A2 / KET High school students - Review Listening activities about describing people and hours from previous classes -Work on speaking and describing people. -Introduce speaking about describing situations and pictures.			
Warm-up and Objective Discussion				
Warm - up activity: Describing people. Go over vocabulary for describing (hair, size, color etc) Give new vocabulary related to describing situations, feelings and places.

Show students a picture where they can see people doing an activity. Describe it showing them how to use adjectives to describe feelings and pictures.

Pull out another photo and ask if anyone would like to give it a try. Help the student with any difficult vocabulary or grammar structure.

Show students the "Speaker's Box" game and explain how to play the game. Have each student take turns putting their hand in the box and pulling out a card. They have to follow the directions for each type of card. Have them take turns talking about their card.
